## TPG Pushes Its NBN Product Offering into the Next Gear

Sydney, 1 May 2015 – TPG has recently launched an aggressive range of NBN with Home Phone Bundle plans. TPG first entered the NBN space a year ago and has now revised its NBN plans to give customers more choices in data usage, speed options and contract terms.

TPG's new NBN plans start from \$39.99 per month (previously \$59.99). For the first time, TPG also now offers NBN plans with up to 25Mbps and 50Mbps download speeds, along with the original 12Mbps and 100Mbps options it previously offered.

TPG's Chief Operating Officer, Craig Levy, believes that the new plans are among the most competitive NBN enabled product range in Australia.

"Our lowest plans with data usage quota are very well suited for light users. The introduction of the 25Mbps and 50Mbps speed options also means that our plans would appeal to users with other telcos who are shopping around" Mr Levy said.

Customers can choose between 18 month contract (\$0 setup) and no lock-in contract (\$99.95 setup). Both contract options come with an included Wi-Fi modem.

The majority of TPG's new NBN product range offer various combinations of included calls such as unlimited local calls, unlimited calls to Australian mobiles and unlimited international calls to selected countries.

"People often ask how TPG can offer such competitive products. We are able to keep costs down and pass the benefit on to customers since we are a nationwide infrastructure owner with extensive domestic and international bandwidth, as well as one of the largest fixed voice operators" added Mr Levy.
